

CCS Buff GP/AS

General Purpose/Auto Scrubber

DESCRIPTION

CCS Buff GP and Buff AS are multipurpose, neutral cleaners for use on polished surfaces and floors sealed with CCS Sheen and CCS Decrathane Semi-Gloss.

CCS Buff GP and Buff AS can also be used on unsealed surfaces to improve presentation and cleaning qualities.

Both cleaners revive surfaces through improving film clarity, gloss levels, durability and by also enabling the treated surface to be more easily buffed.

RECOMMENDED USES

- To improve the lustre on CCS Sheen and Decrathane Semi-Gloss.
- Used as a weekly maintenance product for the CCS Platinum Polish System.
- Ideal for concrete, natural stone, vinyl and tile with a polished sealed surface.

PACKAGING

CCS Buff GP and Buff AS are available in 20 litre containers.

PREPARATION

Clean and prepare floors as per the technical data sheet.

APPLICATION METHOD

Buff GP (General Purpose)

1. Once floor is clean and dry dilute and apply CCS Buff GP as per table below.
2. Using a low pressure sprayer or mop apply CCS Buff GP then buff the surface with a floor polishing machine.

Polish/Sealed Floors	CCS Buff GP	Water
Red Nylon Pad on Floor Polisher	1 part	10 parts
Mop and Bucket	1 part	60 parts

APPLICATION METHOD

Buff AS (For Auto Scrubbing Machines)

1. Dilute 1 part CCS Buff AS to 150 parts water and add to the auto scrubbing machine solution tank.
2. Clean the surface as per machine manufacturer's directions.
3. Allow the surface to dry before buffing.

Note: When using an auto scrubber, ensure all turns and edges are dry mopped, evenly dispersing the product across the floor.

STORAGE

Store CCS Buff GP in a cool dry place away from other chemicals. Container should be sealed tightly whilst in storage. Store away from food.
